1. PROJECT OVERVIEW:

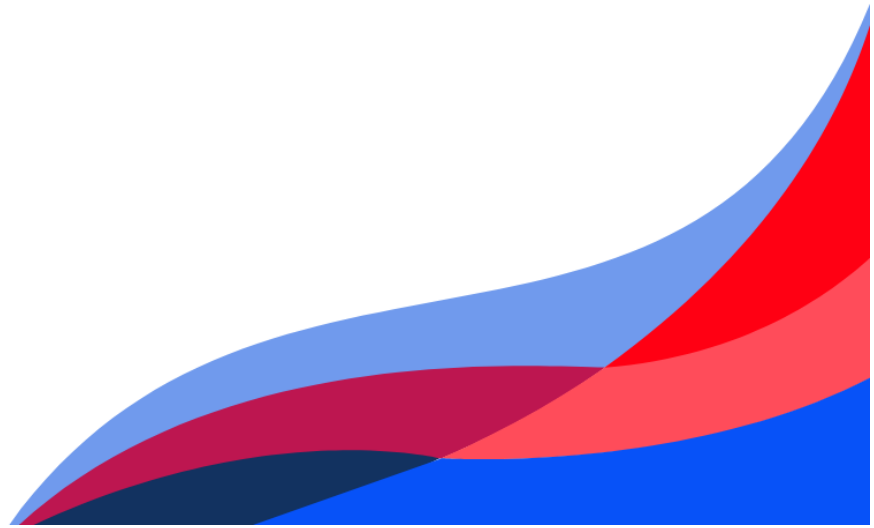

The OPS Network's LENS module will allow agencies to utilize the power of the OPS Network's LENS protocol to share information while not needing access to the other portions of the OPS Network.

For purposes of this document:

- OPS, OPS LENS, OPS Network are interchangeable and are also used to identify the "National Law Enforcement and Community Policing Integrated Network."
- Client/User/NJSP and New Jersey State Police are interchangeable.
- Client, User, Officer, Trooper, Member all refer to potential users of the OPS Network and OPS LENS for purposes of this overview.

2. PROJECT GOAL(S):

- Activate the OPS Network LENS platform within the State of New Jersey and provide access to all NJ law enforcement officers and agencies, as well as provide access (via the appropriate method) for the distribution of information to selected out of state law enforcement fusion centers and approved civilian assets.
- Through the OPS LENS platform, provide users (at a minimum) with the ability to:
 - Securely distribute important information between multiple agencies and officers quickly via a secure and modern law enforcement specific platform.
 - Notify partner agencies and officers about a myriad of investigative and intelligence related matters.
 - View, and quickly respond to, messages, notifications, and emergencies in real-time.
 - Instantly share photos, video, documents, files, and more across jurisdictions.

- Tailor distributions as needed (statewide, specific agencies, counties, civilian assets, etc.)
- Set notification levels (low / medium / high / critical)
- Include authorized civilian entities and assets in the notification chain.
- Search the LENS platform database for names, case details, keywords, etc.
- With NJSP ROIC approval, instantly distribute statewide (all) notifications.
- Receive instant push notifications to any authorized device in real-time.
- Subscribe to receive notifications when responses are posted to an alert.
- View subscribed users and see who is following a notification.
- Limit who can comment or if a notification will appear in the master search.
- Locate biographical and contact details for all users across the platform.

3. PROJECT ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

a. Online Policing Solutions, Inc.

- Online Policing Solutions, Inc., will provide access to the OPS LENS platform to all approved NJ law enforcement users and, via the appropriate method, select out-of-state fusion center members and civilian users.
- Online Policing Solutions, Inc. personnel will provide statewide training to all 21 counties and all NJ state law enforcement agencies on the activation and use of the OPS LENS.
- Online Policing Solutions, Inc. will provide real-time technical support.
- All OPS LENS platform users will be provided access to the OPS Network Support Center and Video Training library.

- OPS will provide continued guidance, training, maintenance, upkeep, and technical support for the life of the New Jersey OPS LENS project.

b. New Jersey State Police:

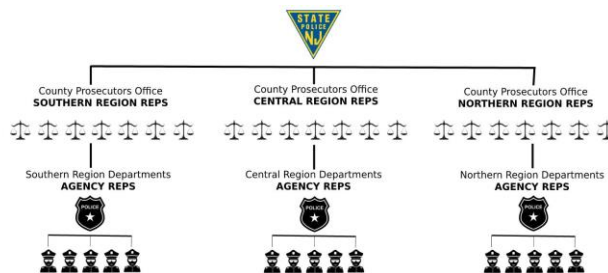
County Training:

- **Phase 1: Initial Rollout and Statewide Training:**
 - *March 1, 2024* - Barring unforeseen factors, beyond the control of Online Policing Solutions, Inc., Phase 1 will begin.
 - *June 31, 2024* - Barring unforeseen factors, beyond the control of Online Policing Solutions, Inc., all authorized users will be provided with the appropriate training and access to the OPS LENS platform.
- **Phase 2: Mobile Application (APP) Deployment:**
 - *September 31, 2024* - Barring unforeseen factors, beyond the control of Online Policing Solutions, Inc., within 3 months of the completion of “Phase 1” the OPS LENS Mobile APP will be made available to all active and registered LENS platform users as well as any newly authorized users.
