Dear Director Ferketic,

The New Jersey State Police is pleased to announce the implementation of an all-new statewide law enforcement notification and intelligence sharing platform. The Law Enforcement Notification & Sharing (LENS) Platform was developed and is operated by Online Police Solutions (See attached flier). LENS will help keep our law enforcement community safe by providing real-time notifications and interactive communications across jurisdictional borders, on a secure and modern law enforcement specific platform. LENS is not an email but rather a communication tool that is intended to replace APBnet Trak Flier software.

The contract with APBnet expires June 30, 2024 and we aim for the training and implementation of LENS to be completed prior to July 1, 2024, at which time we anticipate going "live." LENS will be made available to all state, county, and local law enforcement agencies throughout the State at no cost. Officers will utilize LENS to make notifications to law enforcement members and agencies statewide as well as to select private sector groups and stakeholders such as public officials, hospitals, utilities, and schools.

The initial roll out will be a web-based application accessible through the LENS Application found online. Eventually, LENS will be made available as a phone application to allow instant notifications on our member's devices.

To ensure a seamless transition, we kindly request your agency's participation in the following:

- Appoint a dedicated LENS coordinator to serve as the primary point of contact for your agency.
- Define distribution groups within LENS to facilitate targeted communication and collaboration.

- Identify an Administrator and Assistant Administrator for each distribution group to manage and support user engagement.

To empower your agency to effectively utilize LENS, we will provide comprehensive training in late May or early June 2024 (dates TBD) at the NJSP Hamilton Technology Complex. The LENS Coordinator and group Administrators/Assistant Administrators will attend a 2-hour train-the-trainer session, equipping them to support their teams. Additional online training resources will also be available.

We look forward to collaborating with your agency to leverage the full potential of LENS, enhancing public safety and strengthening our law enforcement community. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact Captain Flory or DSFC Doherty.
